Mouth Watering Potential in Top Cheltenham Street

Built circa 1887 and been in the same family since the late 1800s, this beautifully positioned character villa is a testament to the craftsmanship of the era. Maintained, but virtually untouched in terms of layout and design, you will feel the inspiration of history as you enter the wide and lofty hallway which runs the length of the home. Five main rooms each with untouched period detailing which include; original fireplaces, big bay windows looking over the harbour to the city, kauri floors, and towering batten and board ceilings. With its architectural integrity safely preserved, this potentially stunning home provides a blank canvas to create your dream home. Excellent views are a surprise bonus. Swims at Torpedo Bay or Cheltenham, walks on the mountain, cricket at the park, the convenience of the village and city ferry are all to be enjoyed within a few minutes stroll of this very sought after opportunity. Spacious, quality do-ups are rare in Cheltenham. One family has been unable to part with this homes ambiance for over a century, now its your turn to feel the magic.

The tale of a jewel in Jubilee Ave.....

Occupied by the same family for 118 years, the home boasts links with a succession of trailblazers who've all left their mark in New Zealand history – in photography, the rights of women and children, and design.

Originally built around 1888 for the Burgess family, 1 Jubilee has been home to the Jackson family since 1898– and generations of Jacksons have created countless happy memories there.

Most recently, it was the home and design studio of Gifford Jackson, ONZM, who was born in the house in 1922 and lived there until his death late last year at the age of 93. Widely regarded as 'the godfather of New Zealand industrial design', Gifford designed a diverse range of products – including the Felton Mix shower head, Bic stackable in-trays, numerous Fisher & Paykel appliances, radios, petrol pumps, electric fence components and many more – which have been part every New Zealander's life.

Most astonishing of all was niece Sarah Ward's discovery of a WWI army trunk on bare ground under the house. She and her husband opened it to find her grandfather's WWI lemon-squeezer hat and uniform, unused puttees, belts, holsters, a cache of WWI and WWII training manuals, and even an army-issue prayer book and some family letters and photos.

When Frederick Ernest "F.E." Jackson and his wife Jane moved to the house in 1896, they named it "Lymm Villa" after the Cheshire town where Jane's mother was born.

Jane's parents were celebrated photographers George and Elizabeth Pulman, who had a studio in Auckland's Shortland Street and who left a legacy of historically significant work. Elizabeth – who is believed to be New Zealand's first professional female photographer – developed a particular fascination with photographing Maori, including prominent figures such as Rewi Maniapoto, and members of King Tawhaio's family. Elizabeth's work was back in the headlines recently, when 13 rare examples of her Maori portraits were auctioned in the U.K.



The tale continues.....

Jane and F.E. raised nine children in Jubilee Ave. Living so close to the water inspired F.E. to build the racing yacht *Thistle*, which was a fixture in harbour racing for years. The family also had a horse, which grazed on the then-empty section behind their house.

Sarah was another of the family's trailblazers. Her work running a children's home led to a lifelong commitment to women and children's welfare. Among her many achievements, Sarah was one of the country's first women JPs, sat in the Children's Court, was District Agent responsible for inspecting all foster and children's homes in Auckland, was on the executive of the NZ Society for the Protection of Women and Children, and a life member of the National Council of Women.

Gifford returned at the end of the war and took a job as Fisher & Paykel's first designer – but the bright lights and opportunities of New York beckoned and in 1949 he moved there. He spend the next 17 years there honing his skills with some of America's top design firms and talents – in that heady *Mad Men* era – before returning to New Zealand in the late 1960s and setting up his own studio in his parents Jubilee Ave home.

For Gifford's nieces and nephews, the house has held a lifetime of happy memories. But with his passing they have decided it's time for another family to love the house and write their own Jubilee Ave story.
